Subject: Establishment of Bharati Vidyapeeth's
College of Engineering at New Bombay.

Sir,

I am to refer to your letter No. PEO-1686/215567 (2735)/TE.1-A dated 6th November, 1989 forwarding the above proposal of Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune and to say that on the recommendations of the Standing Committee of the Western Regional Committee the All India Council for Technical Education has approved the establishment of Bharati Vidyapeeth's College of Engineering at New Bombay subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions by the management of the Bharati Vidyapeeth:-

1. That the management including the governing Council of the college shall be as per the guidelines of All India Council for Technical Education.
2. That the Chairman of the Governing Council shall be appointed as per AICTE norms.
3. That the infrastructure and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms and as recommended by the Western Regional Committee.
4. That admission shall be made as per the guidelines of AICTE, issued recently and no capitation fee or donation will be charged for admission.
5. That the accounts of the college shall be audited by the chartered accountant and be open for inspection by AICTE or anybody authorised by it.

6. The tuition and other fees shall be as laid down by the State Government of Maharashtra with in the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE.
7. The staff shall be selected on all India basis by open selection according to procedure, qualifications and experience laid down by AICTE.
8. That the management shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by AICTE.

2. This sanction is conveyed subject to the conditions that the University of Bombay agrees to affiliate this college for conduct of the following courses with total intake capacity of 180 students:-

1. Mechanical Engineering	60
2. Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering	60
3. Computer Engineering	30
4. Instrumentation Engineering	30

3. The AICTE has approved the estimates of non-recurring and recurring expenditure as Rs.545 lakhs and Rs.87.29 lakhs respectively for this institution for conduct of the above courses.

I am to request you to take further necessary action to set up this institution and the progress made in this behalf may kindly be communicated to the Regional Committee under intimation to the AICTE.
